



Josh Daley Racing

Josh had his 1st race meeting at Mallory Park last weekend and did better than we hoped for at his 1st meeting on "big bikes".

There were 48 in Josh's class and the way qualifying works the top 22 go through to the 2 main races (races 1 & 2) then even numbered qualifiers go to races 1 & 3, odd numbered qualifiers to races 2 & 3. Basically Race 3 is like a "B" final.



Josh qualified 19th, and went 2 1/2 seconds quicker than he had on the test day 2 weeks previously. We were both really pleased.

Race 1

Josh was very nervous before the start, and the bike bogged on the line, resulting in him being 28th into the 1st corner. He slowly started climbing back up the field, and finished 20th.

Race 2

Josh got a better start this time, and finished 16th in this race.

Race 3

We made some adjustments to the bike overnight, and Josh got good starts and was having some good scraps on track. He went over 2 seconds quicker in this race than he had qualified!!!! Finished 18th



Race 4

More of the same, Deja Vu of race 3. This topped a cracking 1st meeting off for Josh.

Considering that Josh is on a standard bike that produces just over 28BHP and most of the front runners are tuned bikes producing around 33BHP, Josh did remarkably well, and achieved goals that we had hoped to achieve by mid-season.
